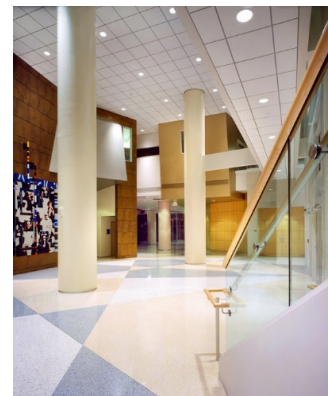
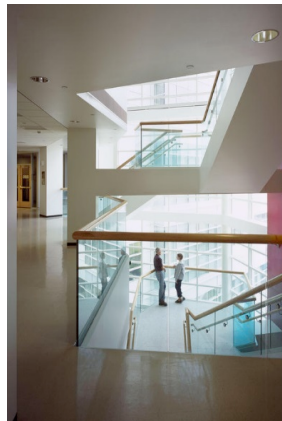

This new 332,000 gross square foot Research Building transforms the typical research lab, hidden behind closed doors, into collaborative architecture that is visible, open and engaging. Designed as a response to its tight site in Cleveland's University Circle, the architecture projects its research image on the urban street front through its materiality and transparency; yet is carved away in deference to the residential scale to its north side. Putting a human face on research, the building fosters interaction and communication through a collaborative and flexible research environment and oasis-like courtyard.
